Open Figure Drawing invites anyone who draws at the Wednesday night drawing sessions to participate in its annual group show. This is an excellent opportunity for first-timers to exhibit work, and for veterans to gain exposure & make sales.

The "Rules"

1. How to Enter

Submit this form and with your artwork on the specified delivery date and time.

2. Delivery & Pickup

Deliver artwork to the Westcott Community Center on Sunday, October 15, 1 - 3 pm, during the Long Pose drawing session. If you're not able to bring the artwork at that time, talk to a board member or host.

Pick up from WCC starts December 6 during figure drawing. Pieces not claimed by March 7 2018 will be auctioned as a fundraiser for OFD Inc. It is your responsibility to arrange pickup.

3. Presentation

All work must be framed & have a wire for hanging from a picture hook. Covering with plexiglass or glass to protect them may insure their safety. If you are using "Swiss Clips" or other systems that leave glass edges exposed you must use plexiglass instead of glass because volunteers have been cut by broken glass with these systems.

4. Eligibility

Anyone who has come to a drawing session within the last year may submit a piece of artwork. This is a non-juried show; everyone is guaranteed their work will be displayed!

If you've attended once, you can submit one piece, twice, two pieces, three or more times, three pieces. The maximum number of pieces you can submit is three.

5. Identify your Artwork

Artwork must have identification and contact information on the back. Include your name, phone number, e-mail and street address to assure proper identification. We also suggest signing and dating your work.

5. Packing the Artwork

We request that you take any materials you used to pack your artwork with you after you deliver your art.

6. Sales

Work can be for sale, but does not have to be. Sales will be handled between the buyer and the individual artist.

7. Catalog

All work is to be published in the OFD Inc. catalog. Submissions may also be used to advertise or promote OFD in print or the Web.
