Open Figure Drawing invites anyone who draws at the Wednesday night drawing sessions to participate in its annual group show. This is an excellent opportunity for first-timers to exhibit work, and for veterans to gain exposure & make sales.

## The "Rules"

### 1. Delivery & Pickup

Pieces must be delivered to the Atrium on Thursday, June 1, 2 - 6:30 pm. Pickup from the Atrium is Monday, August 14, 3 - 7 pm.

### 2. Presentation

All work must be framed & have a wire for hanging from a picture hook. Covering with plexiglass or glass to protect them may insure their safety. If you are using "Swiss Clips" or other systems that leave glass edges exposed you must use plexiglass instead of glass because volunteers have been cut by broken glass with these systems.

### 3. Eligibility

Anyone who has come to drawing sessions 3 times within the last year may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork. If you've come twice, 2 pieces; once, 1 piece. Not sure of your attendance? Then bring in three pieces and we will check the sign-in logs. Our hope is everyone will submit three pieces. This is a non-juried show; everyone is guaranteed at least one piece will be displayed!

### 4. How to Enter

Submit this entry with your artwork to ensure it is included in the Group Show Catalog. Pieces must have identification and contact information on the back. Include your name and phone number (or e-mail or street address) to assure proper identification. We also suggest signing and dating your work.

### 5. Packing the Artwork

Please package your artwork carefully. Recommendations for packing your artwork: Protect the corners; place a piece of cardboard (big enough to cover the frame) over the glass; and place in a garbage bag or other protective wrapping. Be sure to mark all the packing materials with your name or initials. Labeling your packaging material helps us repack it when we take the show down. OFD Inc. takes no responsibility for loss or damage to the pieces. In the history of the shows we have only encountered problems with cracked glass on fast-frame pieces.

### 6. Sales

Work can be for sale, but does not have to be. Sales will be handled between the buyer and the individual artist.

### 7. Catalog

All work is to be published in the OFD Inc. catalog. Submissions may also be used for advertising or other promotions in print or the Web.
