Open Figure Drawing's Group Shows are non-juried and open to everyone. Submissions may be used to advertise or promote OFD in print or on the Web.

Rules

1. Anyone who has ever been to Open Figure Drawing may submit artwork.

You can submit **1 framed piece** of figurative artwork for inclusion **in the show** and our group show catalog.

You may submit up to **2 additional digital images** for inclusion in 35th Anniversary Group Show catalog only.

Submit this form with your artwork.

2. Deliver artwork to the Westcott Community Center* by Wednesday, June 19, 7 - 10 pm, during Open Figure Drawing, or to any session before that. If you're not able to bring the artwork by that time, talk to a board member or host. Email digital images to web@openfiguredrawing.com by June 19.

At the end of the show, **please pick up your artwork directly from the Edgewood Gallery**, on Saturday, August 10, 10 am - 2 pm. If you're not able to pick up your artwork at this time, contact us and we will find an alternate solution.

* or to our new location if we have moved.

3. Artwork must have identification and contact information on the back. An identification tag is on the entry form. Include your name and phone number (or e-mail address) to assure proper identification. We also suggest signing and dating your work.

4. Physical work must be framed & have a wire for hanging from a picture hook. Covering with plexiglass or glass to protect them may insure their safety.

If you are using "Swiss Clips" or other systems that leave glass edges exposed you must use plexiglass instead of glass because volunteers have been cut by broken glass with these systems.

6. Sales

Work can be for sale, but does not have to be.

Edgewood Gallery receives a 33% commission on any artwork sold.

5. Package your artwork carefully

Hint for packing your artwork:

Protect the corners; place a piece of cardboard (big enough to cover the frame) over the glass; and place in a garbage bag or other protective wrapping.

Be sure to mark all the packing materials with your name or initials. This helps us repackage it when we take the show down.

OFD Inc. takes no responsibility for loss or damage to the pieces. In the history of the shows we have only encountered problems with cracked glass on fast-frame pieces.
