OFD will be joining the (R)Evolution Spring Art Show at The Gear Factory for a show to promote OFD and to spread the word about our move to Delavan Studios. We'd like your help by submitting artwork that originates from any OFD session. It can be something you further developed in your own time.

Keep in mind, our 35th Anniversary Show is later in the month. For that show, we are accepting 2 additional digital submissions for the catalog. You can frame either of those and display it in the (R)Evolution show, or choose something else. All artwork in this show will be included in the 35th Anniversary Group Show catalog.

Bring your artwork to Open Figure Drawing's Themed Drawing Session at the Atrium on Sunday, May 5, 1 - 3 pm (or to the WCC earlier before the end of April), with a completed entry form. We may not have any other drawing sessions in May. Please contact Dan Shanahan 315-800-7211 or through our website contact form for more artwork delivery options. We will hang the artwork. After the show, we will bring it to our new location at 413 Delavan Studios.

Submissions may be used to advertise or promote OFD in print or on the Web.

Rules

1. Anyone who has come to a drawing session within the last year may submit 1 piece of artwork from OFD sessions.

Art must not have been in a previous OFD show. As we receive submissions, we will keep you informed through our website, email, and social media if we run out of space.

Submit this form with your artwork.

2. Deliver artwork to the Atrium by on Sunday, May 5, 13 pm, during Themed Drawing. If you're not able to bring the artwork by that time, contact Dan (see above).

At the end of the show, please pick up your artwork from Delavan Studios, on Wednesday, June 19, during Figure Drawing, from 7 - 10 pm, or as soon as you can thereafter.

3. Artwork must have identification and contact information on the back. Identification tags are on the entry form. Include your name and phone number (or email) to assure proper identification. We also suggest signing and dating your work.

4. Artwork must be framed & have a wire for hanging from a pegboard hook. Our Gear Factory space is peg board. Please don't use sawtooth hangers or small rings as hanging devices. They don't work well with the thick hooks.

6. Sales

Work can be for sale, but does not have to be. Sales will be handled between the buyer and the individual artist. Include with your artwork the necessary information for someone to contact you.

7. Package your artwork carefully

Hint for packing your artwork:

Protect the corners; place a piece of cardboard (big enough to cover the frame) over the glass; and place in a garbage bag or other protective wrapping.

Be sure to mark all the packing materials with your name or initials. This helps us repackage it when we take the show down.
